The first sighting took place on December 15, 1966 between 5:30 & 6:00 P.M. The object appeared to be triangular shape and three lights were going on & off. The objects thickness appeared to be small when compared to the length of aside. Four people were in the car which was approximately 6 miles from Woodstown in a southeasterly direction. The car was approaching Woodstown at about 50 miles per hour. The object was going in the opposite direction at about the speed of a blimp. 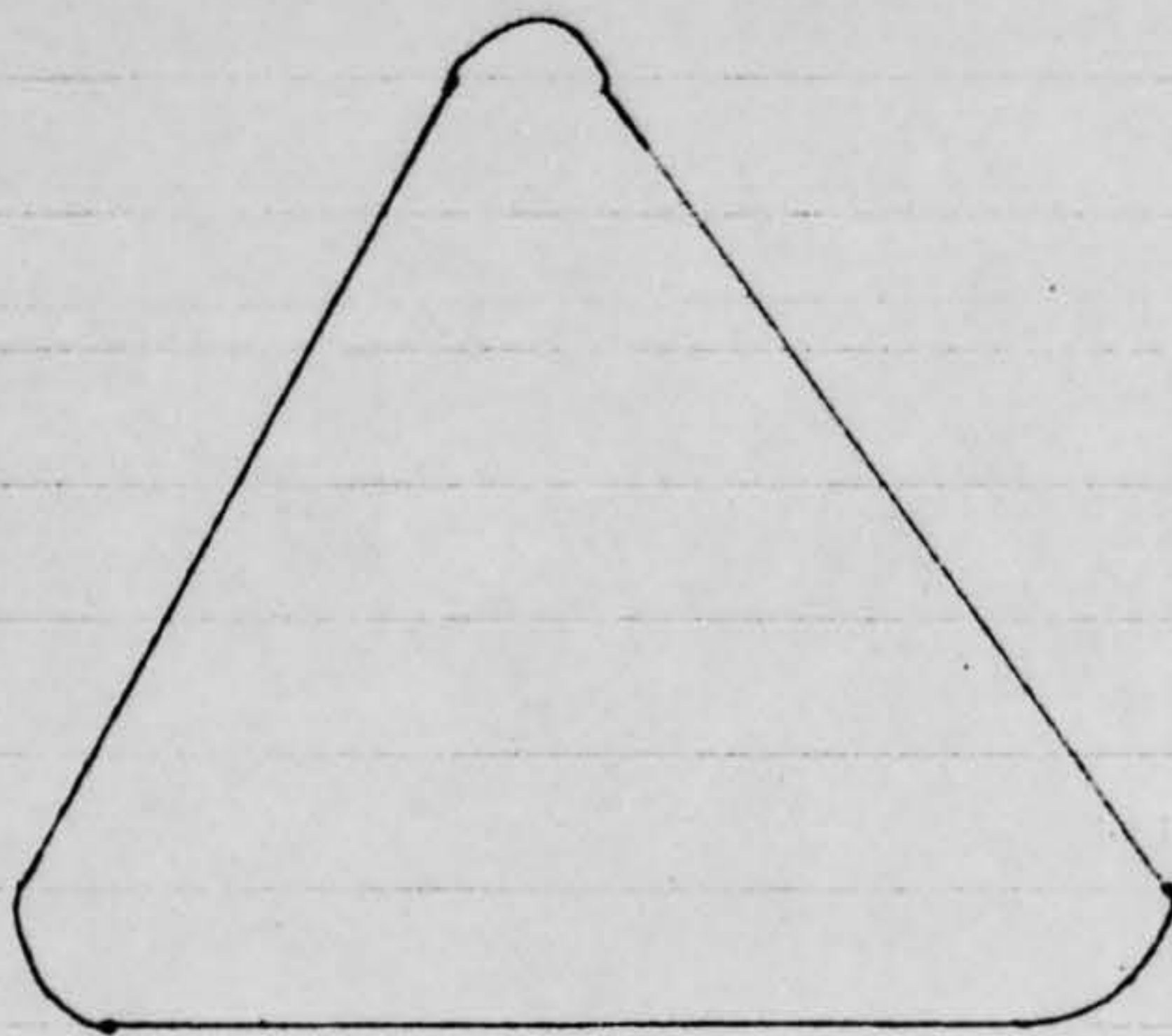
