Gentlemen:

I would like to report what I and others thought to be a U.F.O. On the night of January 24, 1907 at about 7:00 P.M. at Lake City, Pennsylvania. I and others observed with the aid of two telescopes. My Reflection telescope has power 60 to 575 power, at this time it was on 575 power. We observed through my Reflection telescope a very small white blinking light which would go off and on it would be on for 3 seconds then go off and come on again. This small ~~blong~~ blinking was just off the moon's east side and seemed to be moving to the moon's surface very slowly. It was about the size of a pin-head held at arms length (as seen in the telescope). There were 8 observers one would look in the big telescope the other in the small telescope. 1 object. Shape was oval or round. No sound, Color was white. Speed was very slow. Duration. 3 minutes for big telescope; 6 to 7 minutes for small telescope. U.F.O. looked like it was landed on the moon or passing very close to the moon. The big telescope which I had was bump and

I lost the thing. After I got another fixed on the moon it was gone. It was a clear night a full moon. The sky had some clouds. I and my friend have a lot of information on ~~U.S.~~ U.S.O. The Object was no star or planet or even a satellite. We waited for ~~15 to 20~~ 20 to 30 minutes to if we could see the object again but could not see it any more. It may have left the moon while it was behind a large cloud. I and others say they seen it. In the following will be the names of the others, their age and reliability. 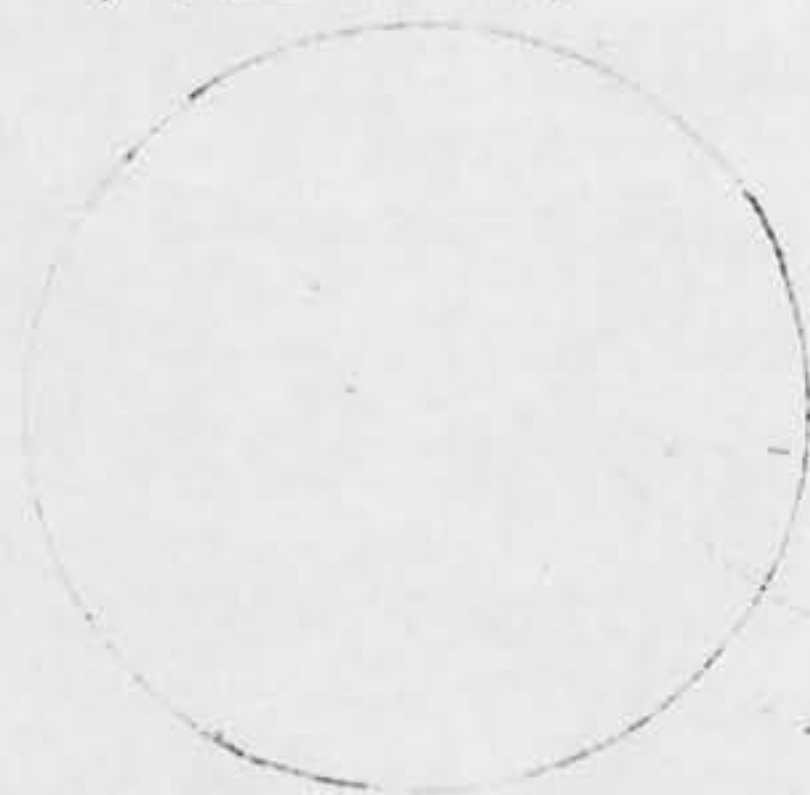

We were outdoors looking through 2 telescopes. It was a cool night, full moon, and scattered clouds. The others said they seen it. The moon was at a 60° angle when sighted. The moon was in ~~the east~~ ^{the east} when we first sighted the object. The object seemed to be near the east end of the moon and travel to the south of the moon. The speed of the object, after talking it over with the observers was very slow. I will be 15 years old this April 7. The object looked like a oval spot-light going off and on.

When we first sighted the object it was just off the east side of the moon. I was the first one to sight it in my large telescope. At this time we were looking at the moon with 2 telescopes. When I first got the moon I moved my scope a little and saw this object going off and on it would keep doing this. The object

(204 seemed to be moving to the south of the moon. The others wanted to take a look and I let them. They said that they seen the object too, and that they could see it very faintly in the smaller telescope. The object could not be seen without the help of the telescopes. The first time I lost it the larger telescope was moved by one of the observers. But I got it back for a few ~~for~~ more seconds when a large cloud came in front of the moon. It was about 3 minutes before the cloud disappeared and we could see the moon again but the object was nowhere in sight of the telescopes. We looked for ~~in~~ it in the sky but could not find it.
