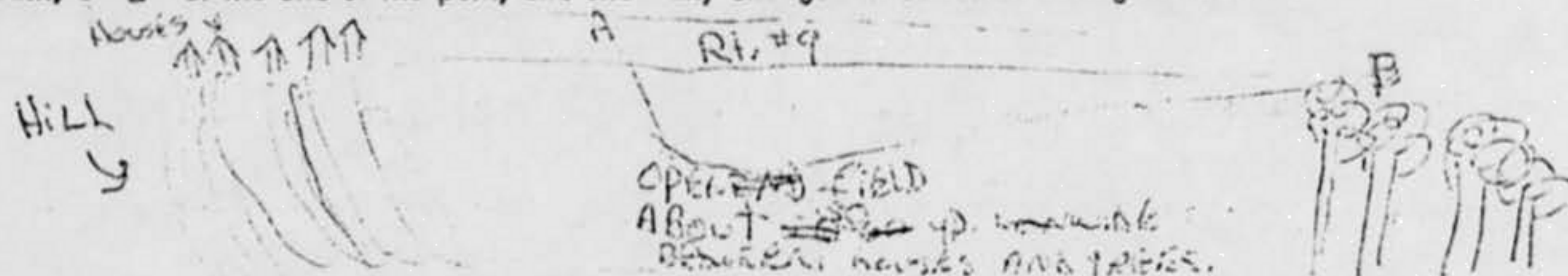

In August 1968 Lt Marano spoke with [REDACTED] regarding his unidentified observation of last summer that he observed with Moscaretolo. [REDACTED] said he definitely saw the object during May, June or July at about 3 o'clock. Saw it for a couple of minutes, maybe one or two minutes, but am not sure. He was standing next to a woods with the object over the trees. The trees were about two-hundred feet high and the object was about 200 feet from him. The object was silver and didn't make any noise. [REDACTED] didn't remember how it disappeared. It moved pretty slowly. Couldn't compare it with any objects. There was only one object. We were just in the front yard and ran in the house and then right back out. No one was outside. Lt Marano asked him why they only took one picture. and he replied "I don't know." Lt Marano asked him if he had time to take more than one picture and he replied "Yes." He doesn't belong to UFO clubs and is now 13 years old. His phone number is [REDACTED]. Lt Marano asked him why he didn't return the forms. "I didn't have time to return them." Lt Marano asked him if he reported it to his parents. "YES." Lt Marano asked him when his parents would be home "I don't know." Lt Marano asked him if they are home during the day. "No." He then asked if they were home during the evening "Yes, and [REDACTED] parents are home during the day."

1. PURPOSE: This report is in reply to Work Order Number 67-111, submitted by Major Quintanilla TDET/UF, requesting photo analysis be accomplished on a photograph of an "unidentified flying object" to determine what the object may be. The object was photographed in Old Bridge, New Jersey on 5 April 1967.

2. ANALYSIS: The object appears to be circular in planform and the only detail discernible is a small unidentified protuberance located at the bottom center of the object. Although the photography appears to be authentic, the object could not be identified from the available evidence.
