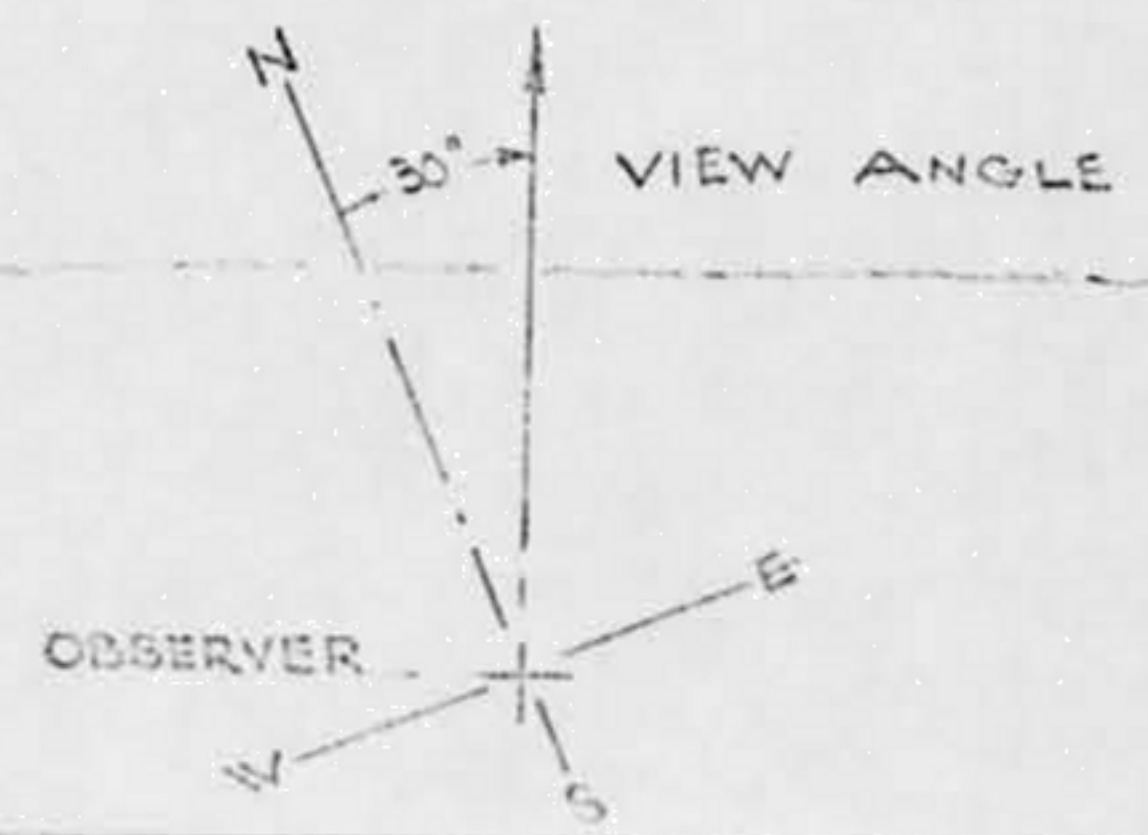

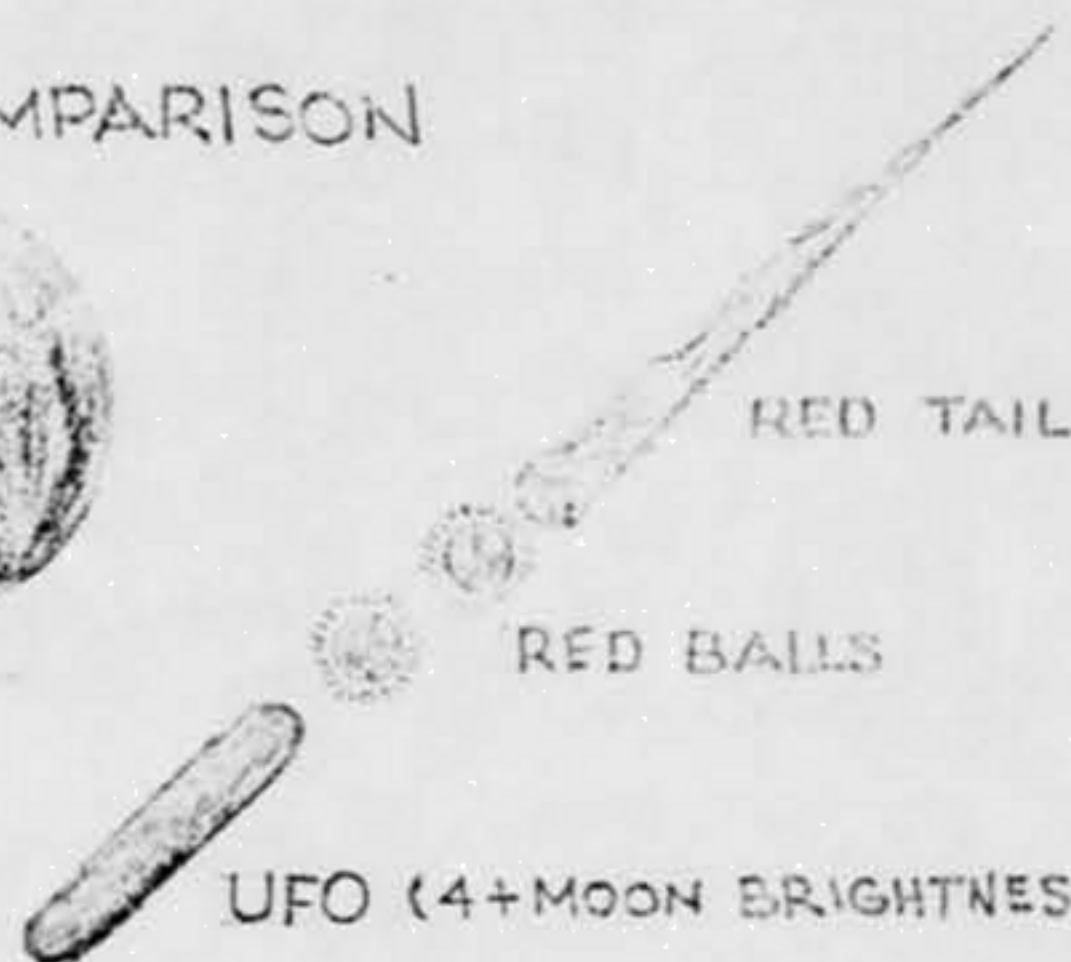

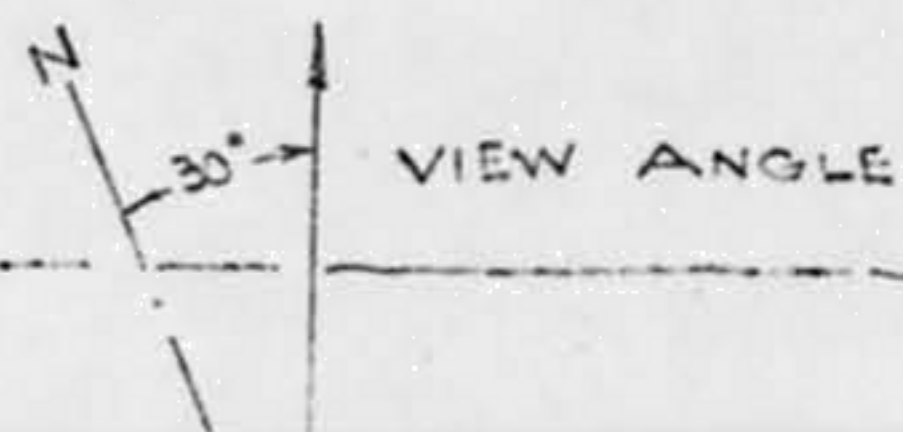

(1) SHAPES OF THREE OBJECTS: NON-CONNECTED WITH EACH OTHER:

(A) CYLINDRICAL/TUBULAR

(B) CIRCULAR BALLS

(C) ELONGATED, NARROW CONE TAPERING TO A POINT; JAGGED-LIKE, RESEMBLING UNOPENED LADY'S FAN

(2) SIZE COMPARED TO KNOWN OBJECTS:

(A) CYLINDER: LENGTH IDENTICAL WITH DIAMETER OF THE MOON; WIDTH APPROXIMATELY ONE FIFTH OF MOON'S DIAMETER.

(B) BALLS: SIZE OF A TWENTY FIVE CENT COIN (QUARTER).

(C) TAIL: LENGTH TWICE THAT OF THE CYLINDER; GREATEST WIDTH: THE DIAMETER OF A QUARTER; NARROWEST WIDTH: PIN-POINT.

(3) COLOR:

(A) CYLINDER: WHITE

(B) BALLS: RED

(C) TAIL: RED

(4) NUMBER: ONE CYLINDER; TWO BALLS; ONE TAIL.

(5) FORMATION: ONE. SINGLE FILE: CYLINDER, FOLLOWED BY FIRST BALL, FOLLOWED BY SECOND BALL, FOLLOWED BY RED TAIL.

(6) DISCERNIBLE FEATURES OR DETAILS: NO TRAILS OR CONNECTIONS AMONG FOUR OBJECTS. CLEAR SPACE (SKY) BETWEEN EACH TWO OBJECTS OF ENTIRE FORMATION.

(7) TAIL, TRAIL OR EXHAUST: RED TAIL DESCRIBED IN RESPECTIVE THREE SUBPARS(C) ABOVE.

(B) SOUND: NEGATIVE

(9) OTHER PERTINENT OR UNUSUAL FEATURES:

(A) VACANT SPACES OF CLEAR SKY BETWEEN EACH TWO OBJECTS:
APPROXIMATELY QUOTE ONE INCH UNQUOTE SIZE OF EACH SPACE.

(B) CYLINDER'S LIGHT INTENSITY, IN ASTRONOMICAL TERMS
FOR STARS: FIRST MAGNITUDE; OBSERVER'S REMARK QUOTE FOUR OR FIVE
TIMES BRIGHTER THAN A STAR UNQUOTE.

(C) ESTIMATED MEAN ALTITUDE: APPROX 7 OR 8 ANGELS;
QUOTE ONE FOOT ABOVE THE TREE-TOPS UNQUOTE.

(D) OBSERVER AT FIRST THOUGHT IT WAS QUOTE A FALLING STAR
UNQUOTE (METEORITE).

(E) THE RED TAIL RESEMBLED A FLAME SIMILAR TO THAT EMAN-
ATING FROM AN AFTER-BURNER ON A JET-PROPELLED AIRCRAFT.

B. DESCRIPTION OF COURSE OF OBJECTS:

(1) FIRST NOTICE BY OBSERVER: OBSERVER, DRIVING HIS POV,
STOPPED AT RED TRAFFIC STOP LIGHT, SAW OBJECTS APPEAR THROUGH WIND-
SHIELD, UPPER RIGHT CORNER, (POSITION: TWO O'CLOCK).

(2) OBJECTS WHEN FIRST OBSERVED: (ESTIMATES)

(A) ELEVATION: 50 TO 55 DEGREES

(B) AZIMUTH: 30 DEGREES (NNE)

(3) OBJECTS ON DISAPPEARANCE: (ESTIMATES)

(A) ELEVATION: 35 TO 40 DEGREES

(B) AZIMUTH: 355 TO 360 DEGREES (PRACTICALLY DUE N)

(4) DESCRIPTION OF FLIGHT PATH AND MANEUVERS OF OBJECTS:

THE UFO APPROACHED FROM NNE, APPEARING AT FIRST MERELY STAR-LIKE. FLIGHT PATH WAS TOWARDS WEST AND TO LOWER ALTITUDE. STAR-LIKE OBJECT THEN RESOLVED ITSELF, IN CLEAR DETAIL, INTO THE FORMATION OF FOUR OBJECTS, IN SINGLE TRAIL ECHELON. FOUR OBJECTS DESCENDED TO BOTTOM OF A HYPERBOLA CURVE. FORMATION THEN CHANGED COURSE TO NNW AND ASCENDED INTO HIGHER ALTITUDE TO DISAPPEARANCE.

(5) METHOD OF DISAPPEARANCE OF OBJECTS:

(A) FADED SLIGHTLY IN ILLUMINATION MAGNITUDE FOR APPROX ONE SECOND.

(B) ALL FOUR OBJECTS DISAPPEARED SIMULTANEOUSLY, ONE SECOND AFTER FADING, TO NORTH BY WEST.

(6) OBJECTS VISIBLE: FIVE TO TEN SECONDS.

C. MANNER OF OBSERVATION:

(1) GROUND VISUAL: THROUGH THE FRONT WINDSHIELD OF A POV.

(2) OPTICAL AIDS USED: NEGATIVE

(3) SIGHTING DID NOT OCCUR WHILE OBSERVER WAS AIRBORNE.
