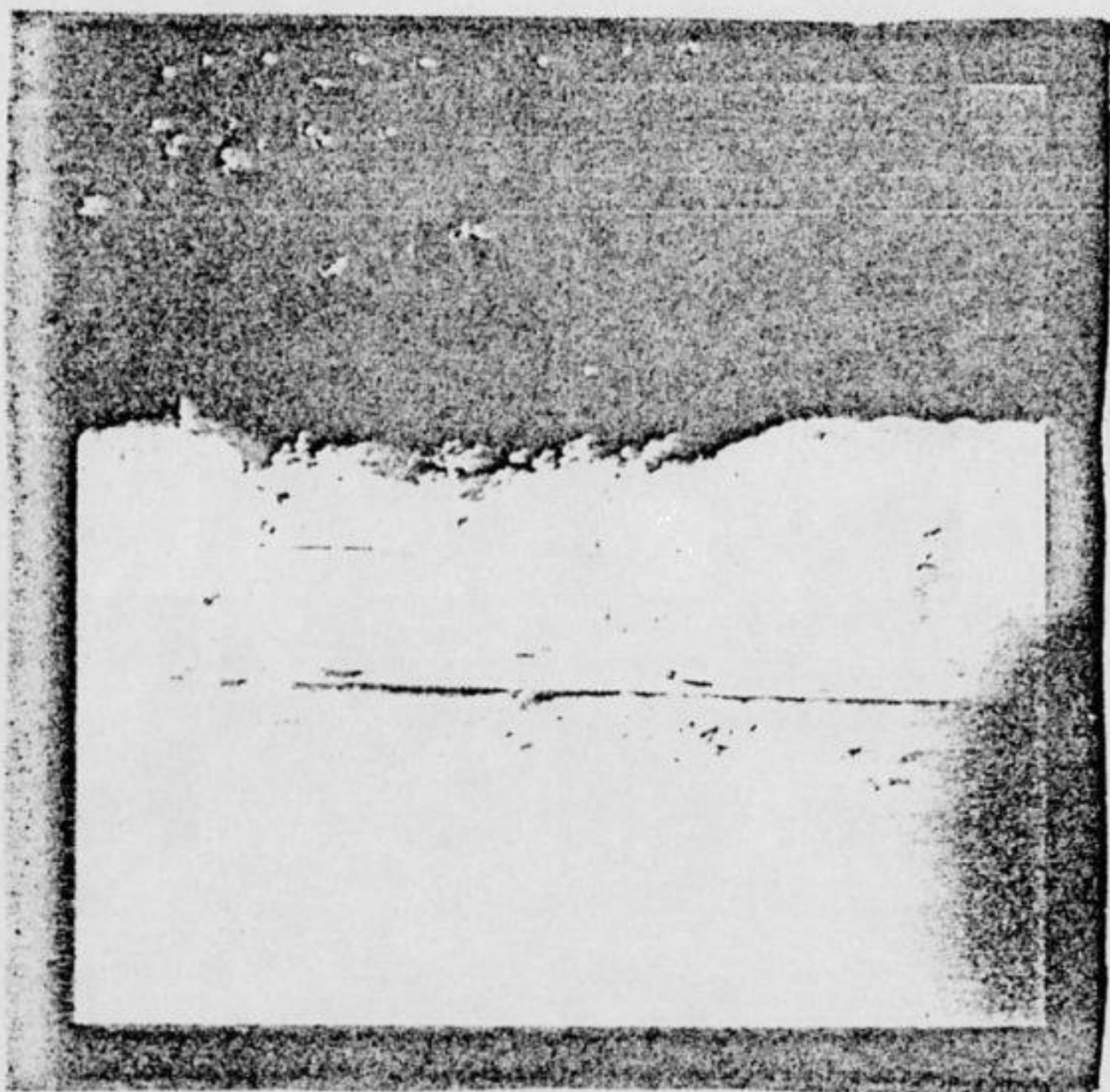
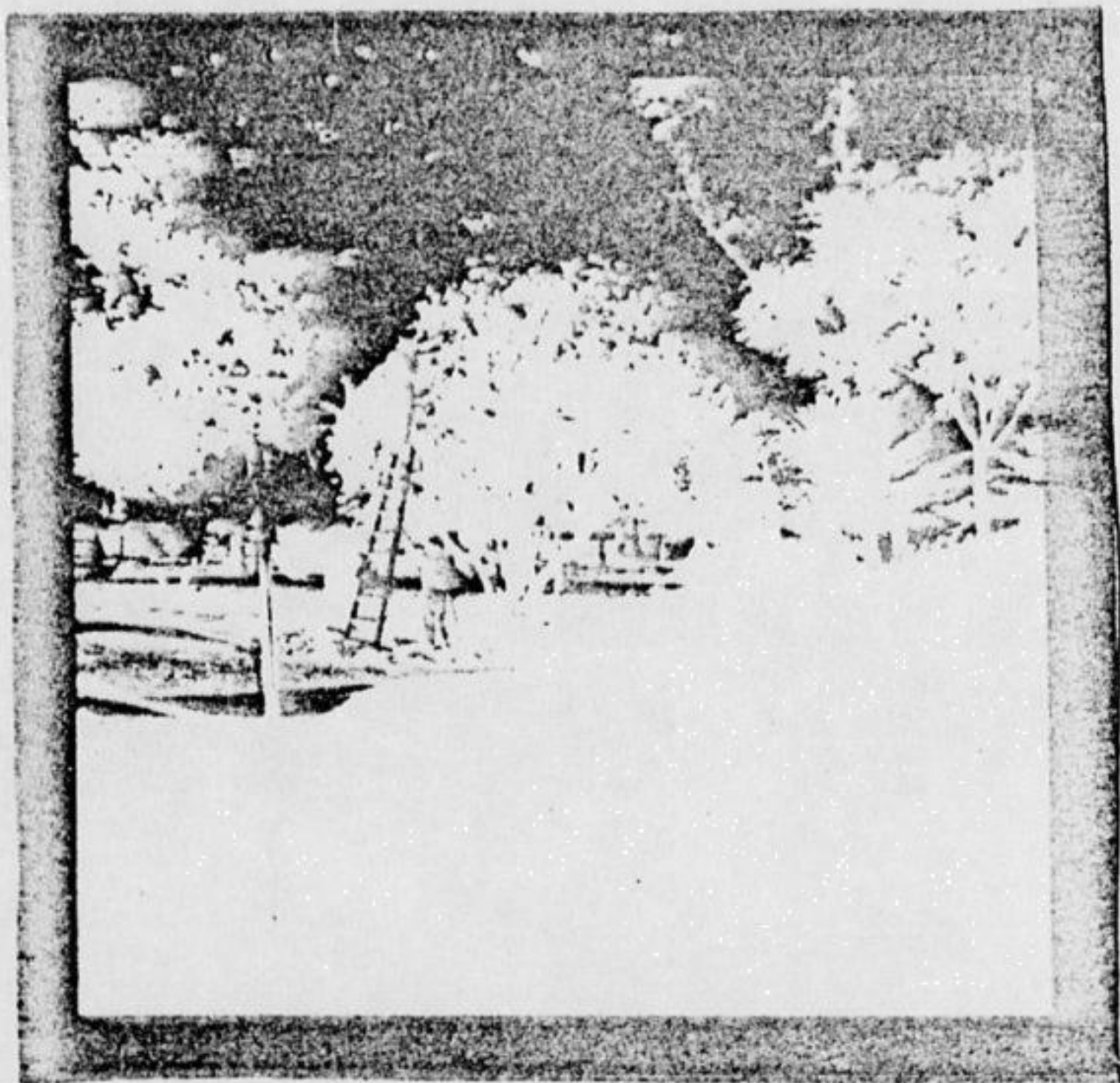
Gentlemen:

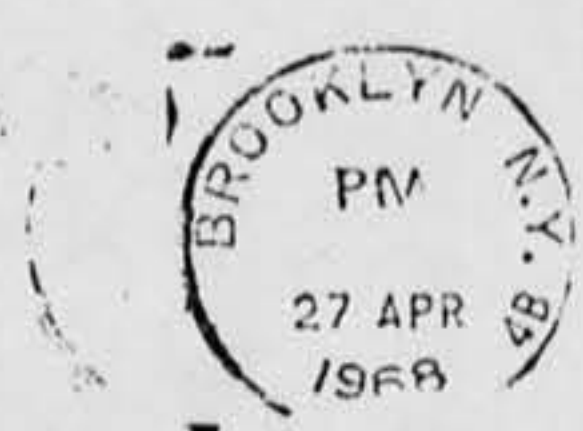
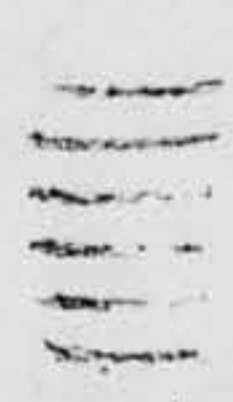
By my study I found that a photograph was taken of a "satellite", a yellow-white egg-shaped object of unknown type and origin which carried astronauts White and McDivitt, on the 20th revolution of their four-day space flight on June 4, 1965. McDivitt was over Hawaii when he sighted the object. He was using 16mm Eastman color film operating at six frames per second. The camera was equipped with a 5mm, 150-degree field of view lens.

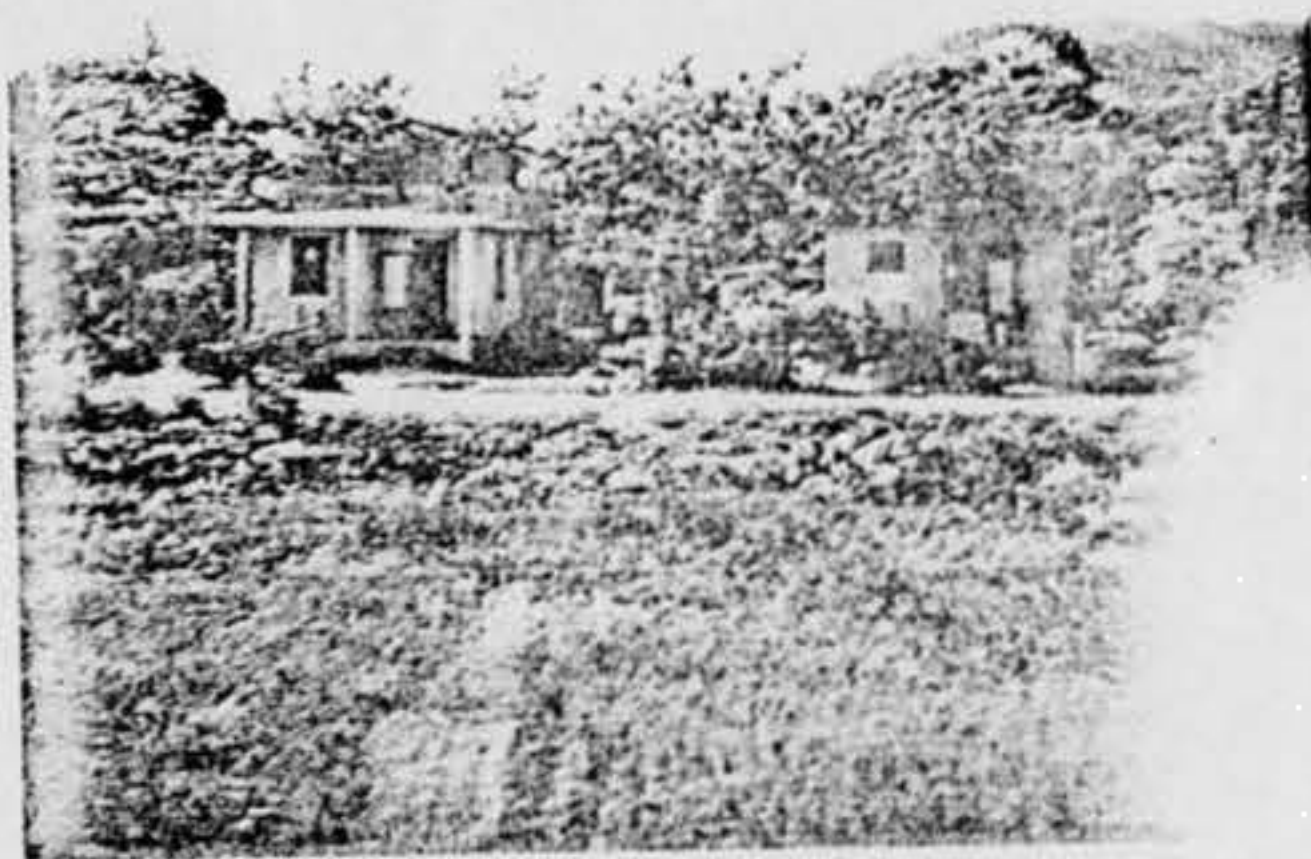

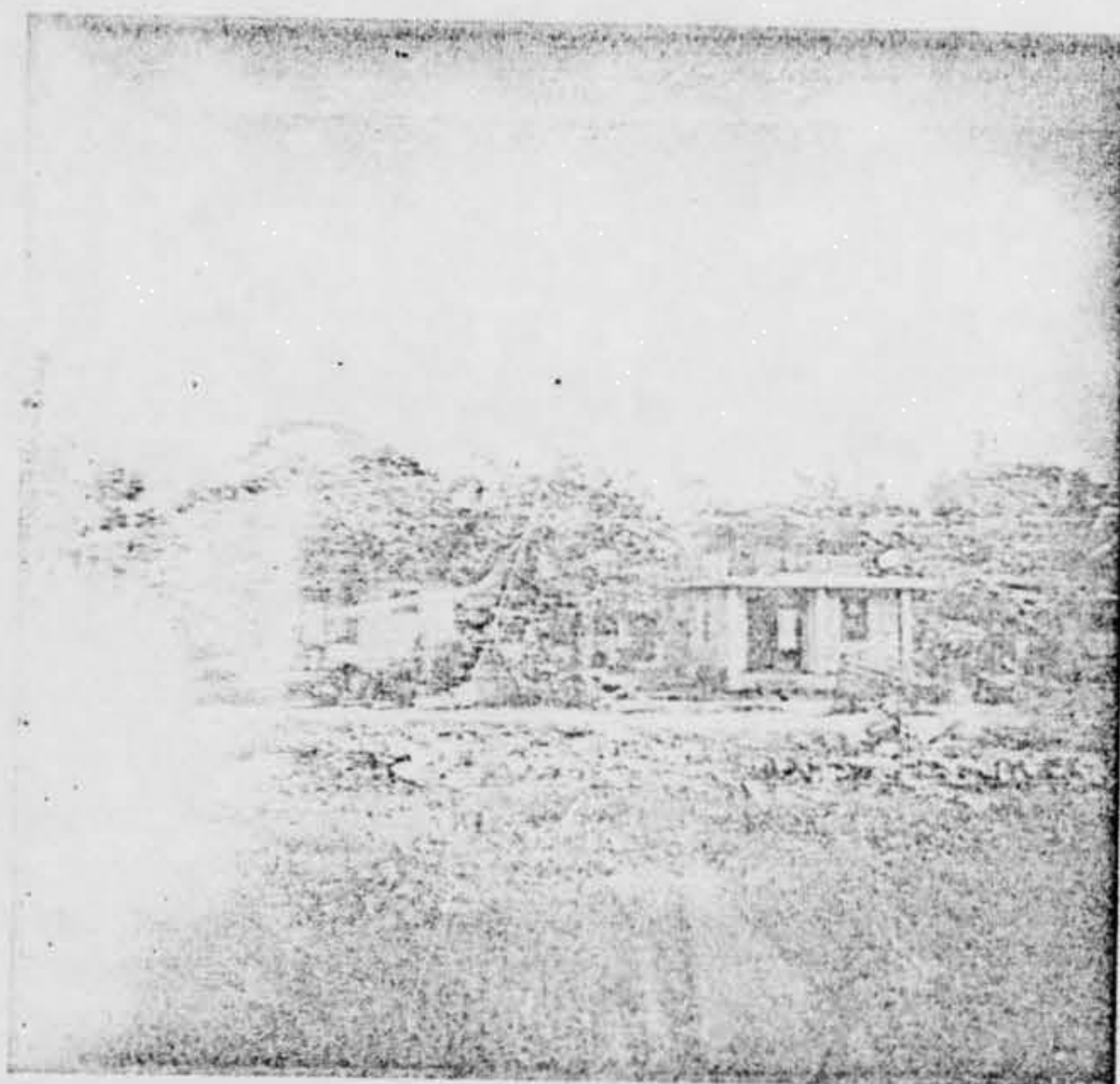

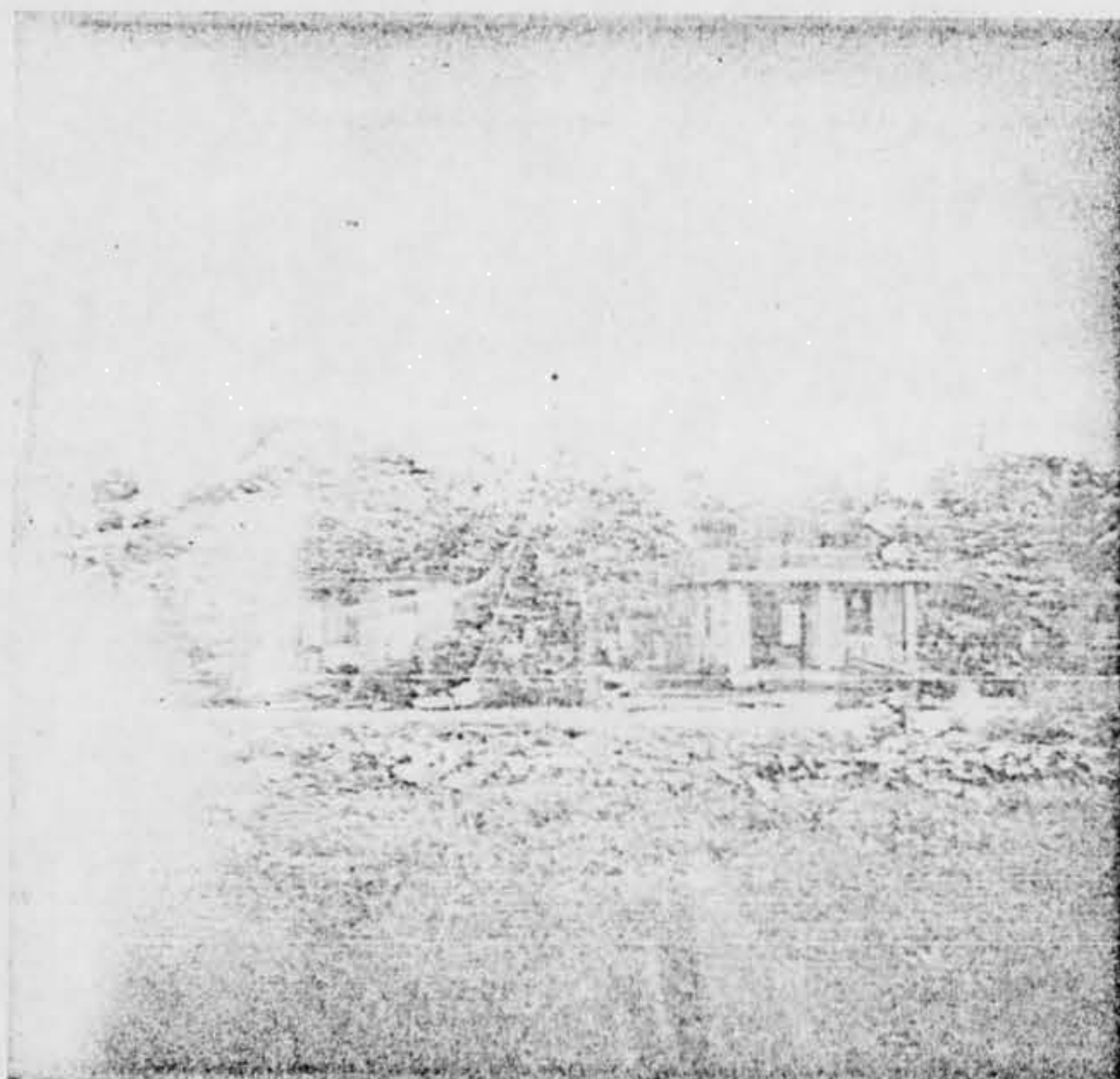
1. The following analysis resulted from examination of a single color print and the corresponding original negative by TDDPP personnel.
2. The dark spot on the print results from the presence of foreign material on the film prior to exposure. There is no density in the spot area on the negative and the very irregular edges are much sharper than the actual imagery.
