[REDACTED] spoke with Lt Marano on 3 Apr 1968 regarding his observation of an unidentified object on 3 March. The State Highway Patrol had provided his name and telephone number to Lt Marano.

TIME: 2:30 pm, local time
DATE: 3 March 1968
DURATION: Five to ten seconds
COLOR: SILVERY
NOISE: Like tin wobbling
DIRECTION: Object was going East
DISAPPEARANCE: Object disappeared over a hill (horizon)
ELEVATION: At appearance 20 deg At disappearance aprox 20 deg
Estimated it to be at 1000 ft alt.
SHAPE: Looked like a kite, bottom side up with big part on bottom.

COMMENTS: Object appeared to be going sideways, thought the wind was pushing it. [REDACTED] did not report his observation to anyone officially for many people thought he would be regarded as crazy. He was cutting trees at the time of his observation. He will complete an AF Form 117.
