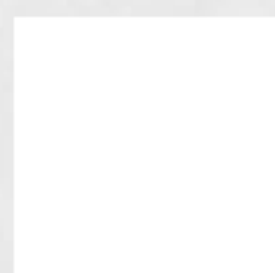

This will reply to your undated letter, in which you described your sighting of an unidentified flying object (UFO).

Without additional information, we cannot offer an explanation of what you saw. However, if you will complete the attached questionnaire and mail it in the inclosed envelope, our technical people at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base will be able to investigate further and make an evaluation.

Should you ever sight another UFO, please report it as soon as possible to the nearest Air Force base. Each base has a UFO investigator, who is in a better position to make an on-the-spot investigation, which usually results in a more accurate analysis.

In the meantime, you might be able to identify the sighting yourself by looking at the categories of objects often reported as UFOs in the Project Blue Book report we are inclosing.

Dear Sir

Last night 7/1/68 I saw a yellow elliptical object at an elevation of 50° & an azimuth of 90° . I could not see any planets or stars but the moon was out & the seeing was fair. It spanned more than $5'$ so it could not be Jupiter & it was of a different magnitude than Venus. It faded slowly & vanished in the 2 minutes of observation. There were no bright lights in my vicinity.

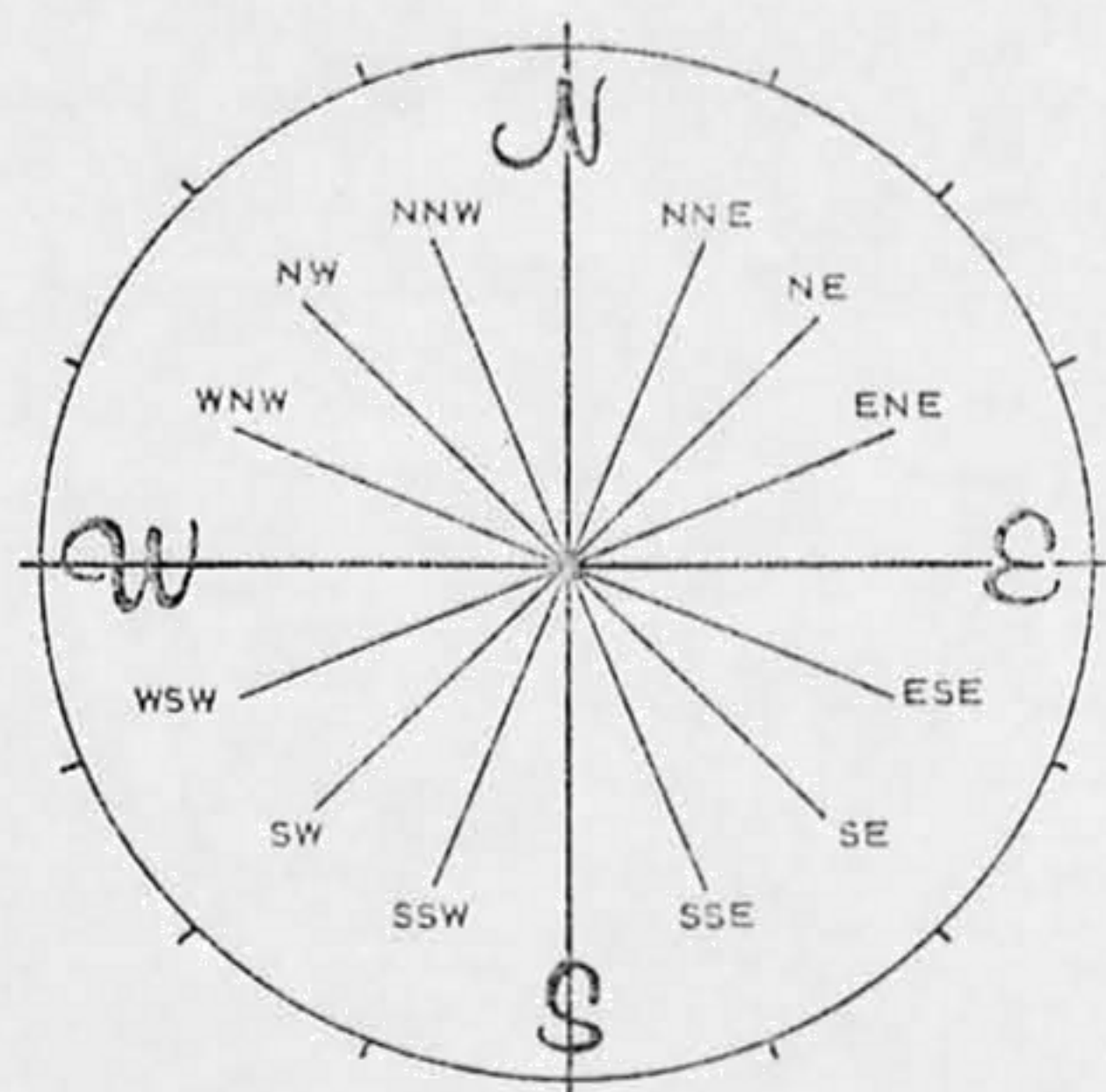

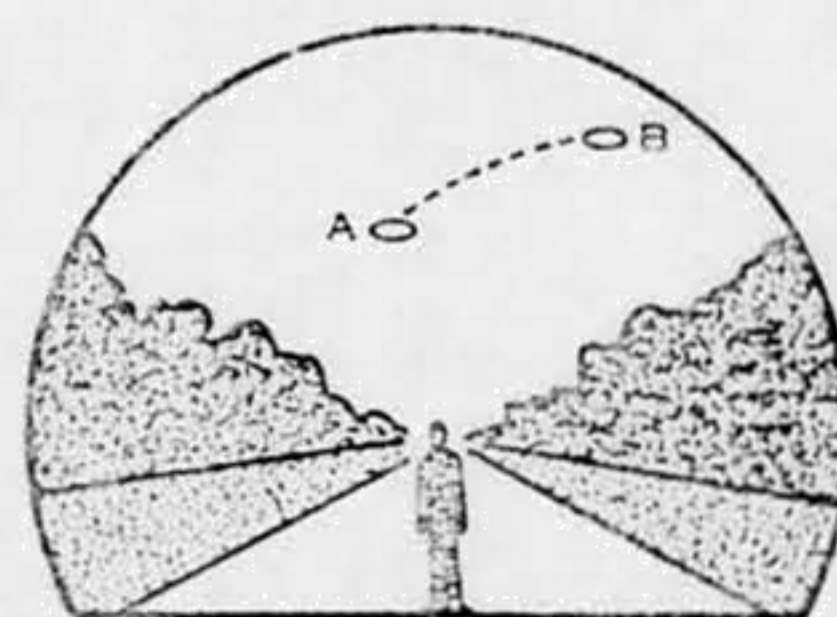
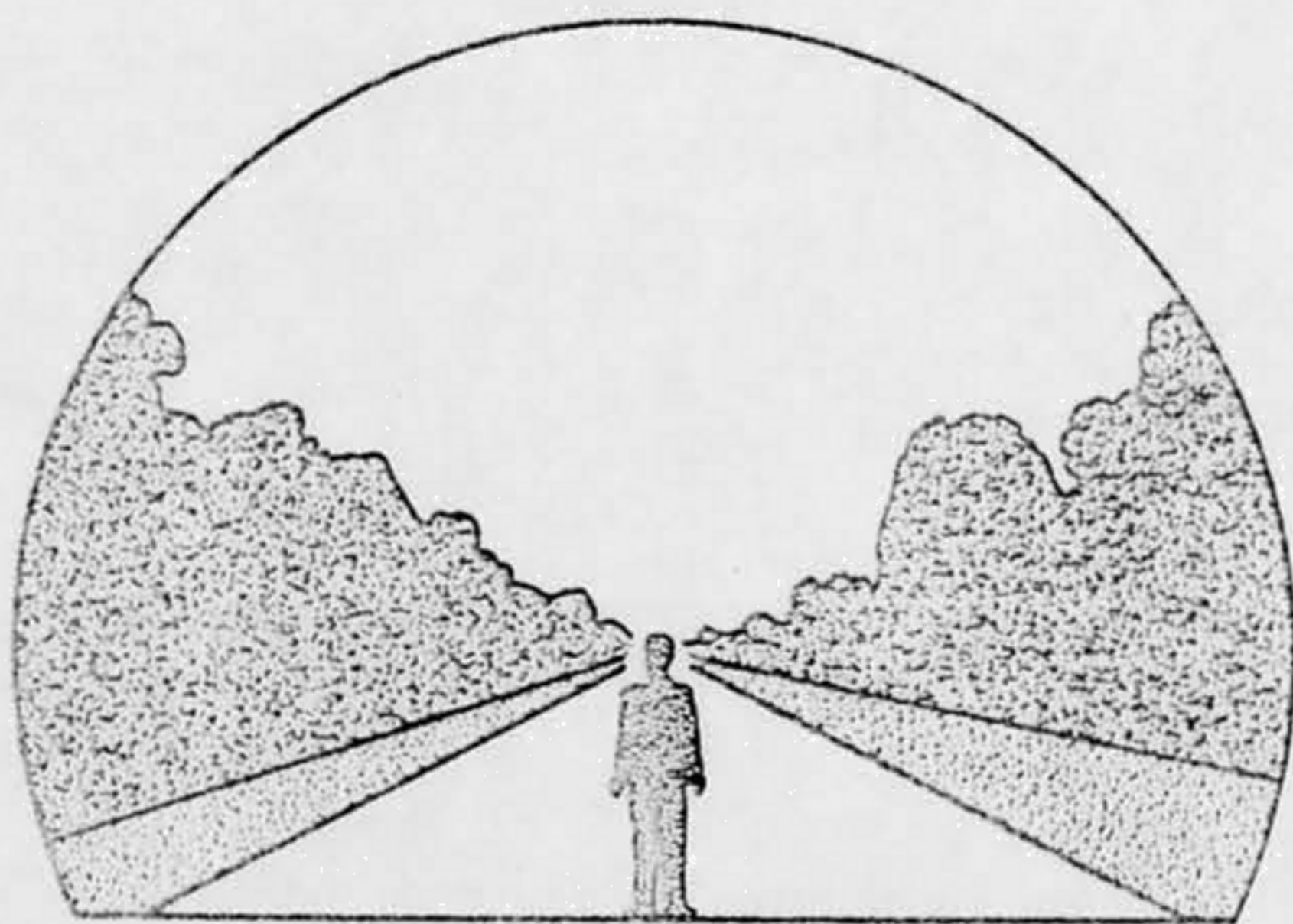
