1. Reference your unidentified observation of 7 July 1968, which you reported to the Secretary of the Air Force, Office of Information, in Washington, D C.
2. Our satellite records indicate that at 1:33 am, EDT, 7 July 1968, ECHO II was at 59° latitude, 79° longitude. The satellite was at an altitude of 640 miles, traveling roughly from the north to the south, and may have been visible from your position (approximately $74^{\circ}30'$ longitude, $41^{\circ}30'$ latitude). At 1:38 am, the satellite was at $44^{\circ}30'$ latitude, 74° longitude, 649 miles altitude and should have been visible from your position. Sometime between 1:38 and 1:42 am, ECHO II passed into the earth's shadow and would not have been visible any longer.
3. This means that at approximately 1:33 - 1:34 am, ECHO II should have been visible low on the horizon to your north-northwest. The satellite has a stellar magnitude of -1 and would have been brighter than most stars. The satellite would have continued to gain elevation and would suddenly have disappeared at about 1:40 am, almost directly overhead. Thus, ECHO II appears to be the stimulus for your sighting, as you described it in the AF Form 117 that you completed.
4. Once again, thank you for reporting your observation to the Air Force.

This will reply to your letter of July 7, 1968, in which you described your sighting of an unidentified flying object or UFO.

Without additional information, we cannot offer an explanation of what you saw. However, if you will complete the attached questionnaire and mail it in the inclosed envelope, our technical people at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base will be able to investigate further and make an evaluation.

Should you ever sight another UFO, please report it as soon as possible to the nearest Air Force base. Each base in the United States has a UFO investigator, who is in a better position to make an on-the-spot investigation, which usually results in a more accurate analysis.

In the meantime, you might be able to identify the sighting yourself by looking at the categories of objects often reported as UFO's in the Project Blue Book report we are inclosing.

Dear Sirs:

It was very early Sunday, July 7, 1968, at 1:30 A.M. in Woodridge, New York, where I was spending my vacation. That I, myself, and several other people watched the Big Dipper seem to move.

At first, it looked normal, but then the lower 4 stars that make up the pan twirled (see diagram). The 2 stars beneath the handle went into a spinning motion, as turning a pencil from point to eraser and back to point. The 2 stars to the right of the 2 mentioned above, went toward the right and vanished.

The first pair of stars which I mentioned twirled, after making one complete rotation, swung off and followed a pattern that of the Dipper, in that shape. a

It was clear, and the stars were shining.
Observations were made by bare eyes and by
binoculars. The process ended at 1:40 A.M.,
10 minutes later.

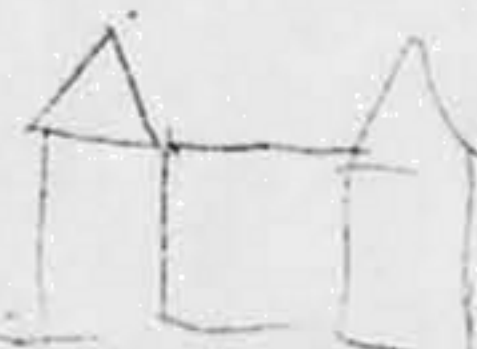

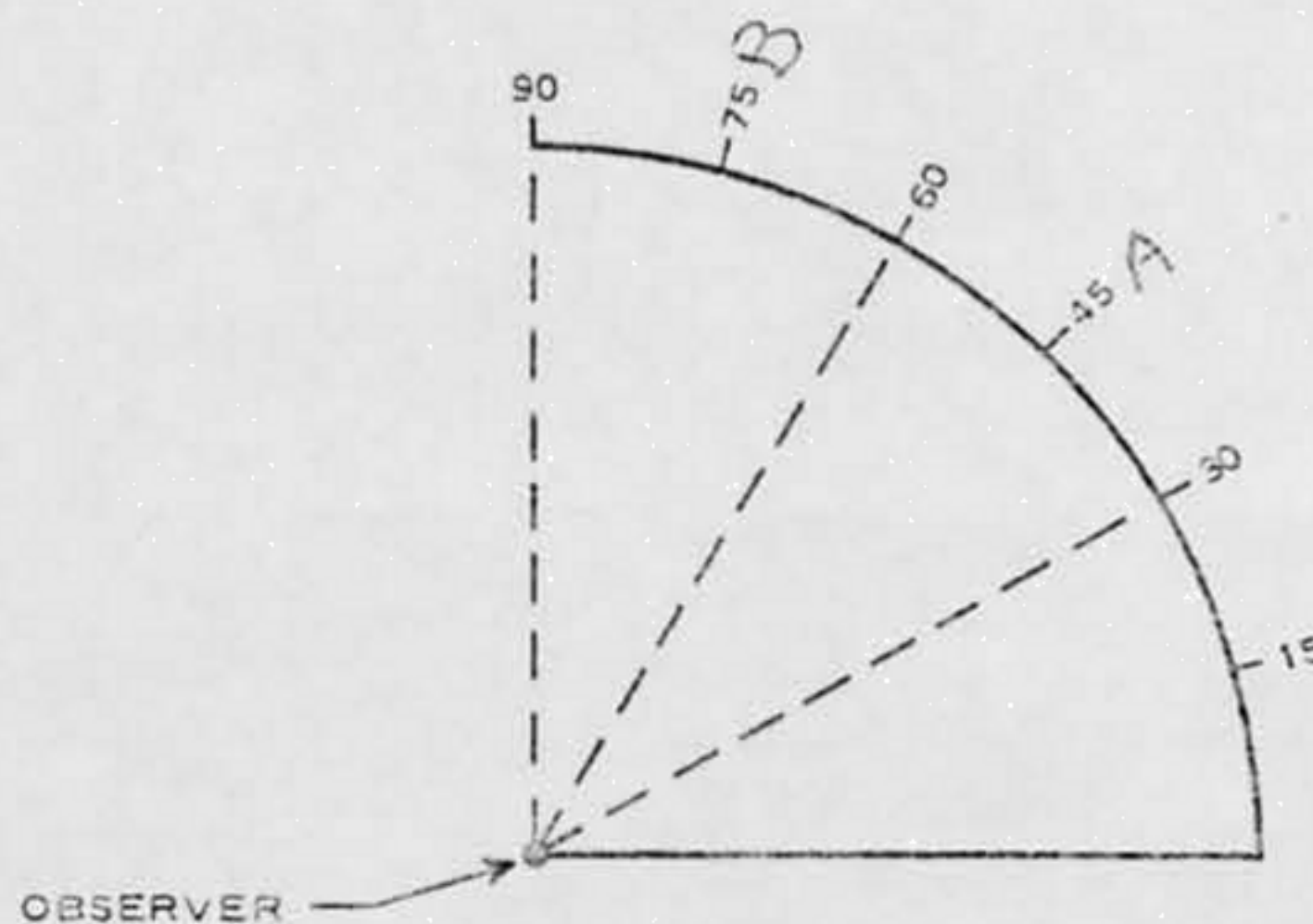

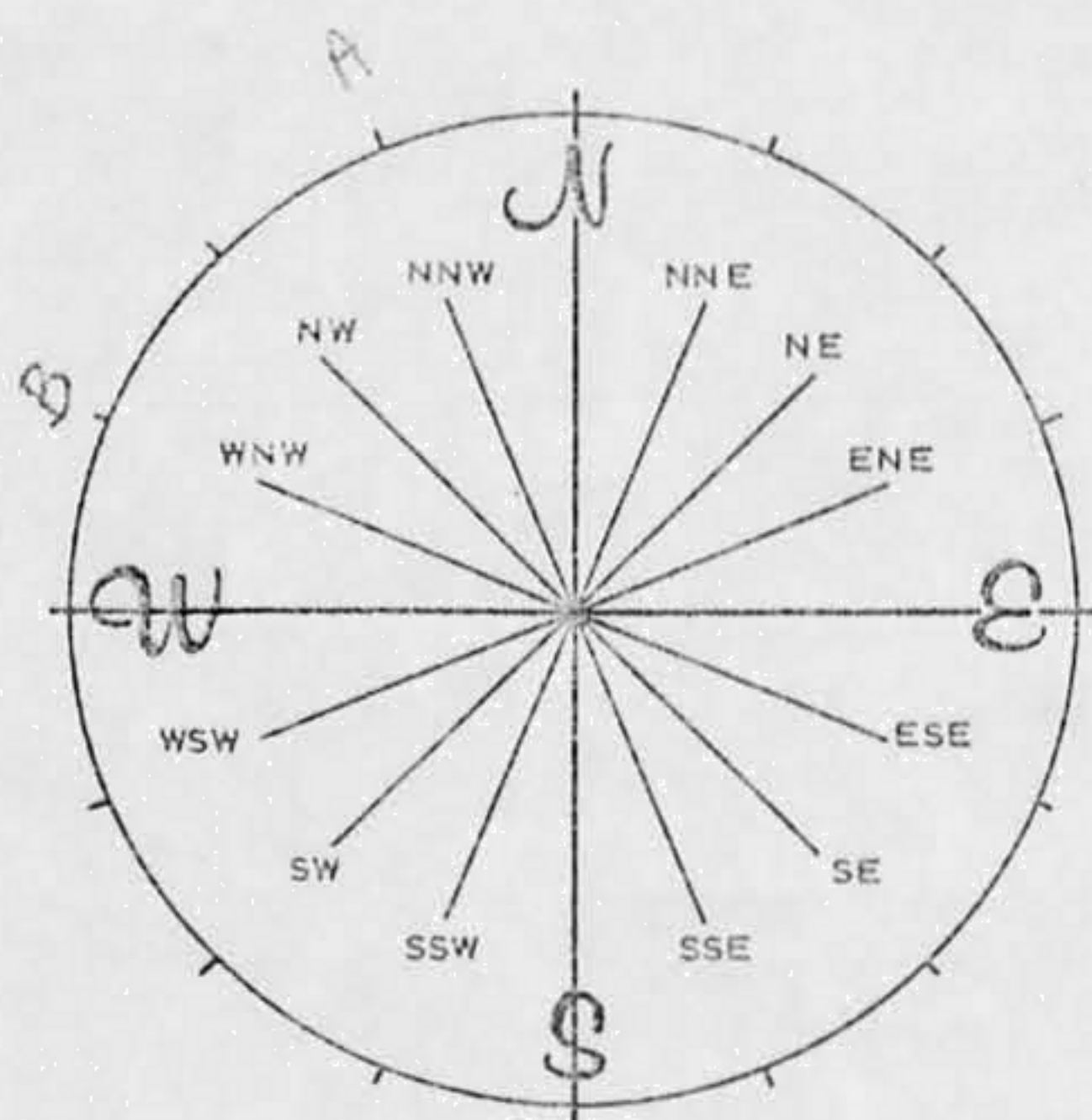
