Without additional information, we cannot offer an explanation of what you saw. However, if you will complete the attached questionnaire and mail it in the inclosed envelope, our technical people at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base will be able to investigate further and make an evaluation.

Should you ever sight another UFO, please report it as soon as possible to the nearest Air Force base. Each base has a UFO investigator, who is in a better position to make an on-the-spot investigation, which usually results in a more accurate analysis.

In the meantime, you might be able to identify the sighting yourself by looking at the categories of objects often reported as UFOs in the Project Blue Book report we are inclosing.

Dear Sirs:

Last Thursday, a friend and I experienced a frightening experience. His name is [REDACTED] Lane, South Zanesville, Ohio. Send him the same return letter you send to me. We were camping out in a tent about two hundred (200) feet from the nearest house. We were sitting down outside the tent putting pieces of grass in-between our thumbs and blowing on them to make a loud shrilling kind of noise. We then at the next moment observed a very dim beam of light on the ground a few feet in front of us. We thought it was [REDACTED] rather with a flashlight shining it down near us, but then remembered that [REDACTED] had the only flashlight of the family. We dove into the tent and grabbed out our flashlights and went back outside and shown them up against some trees wondering who showed that beam in front of us. I then saw the same thing happen again up in a tree (a dead tree with no leaves about 20 feet in the air. Then I showed my flashlight on the tree and there was nothing there. Steve saw the same when he was looking through a clearing through a bunch of trees shining right in front of him not less than 15 feet in front of him. He showed his flashlight on the path of the mysterious beam only to experience the same thing I experienced, that nothing was behind the light and beam was nowhere in sight for the rest of the evening. We would like to know your opinion on what we saw.

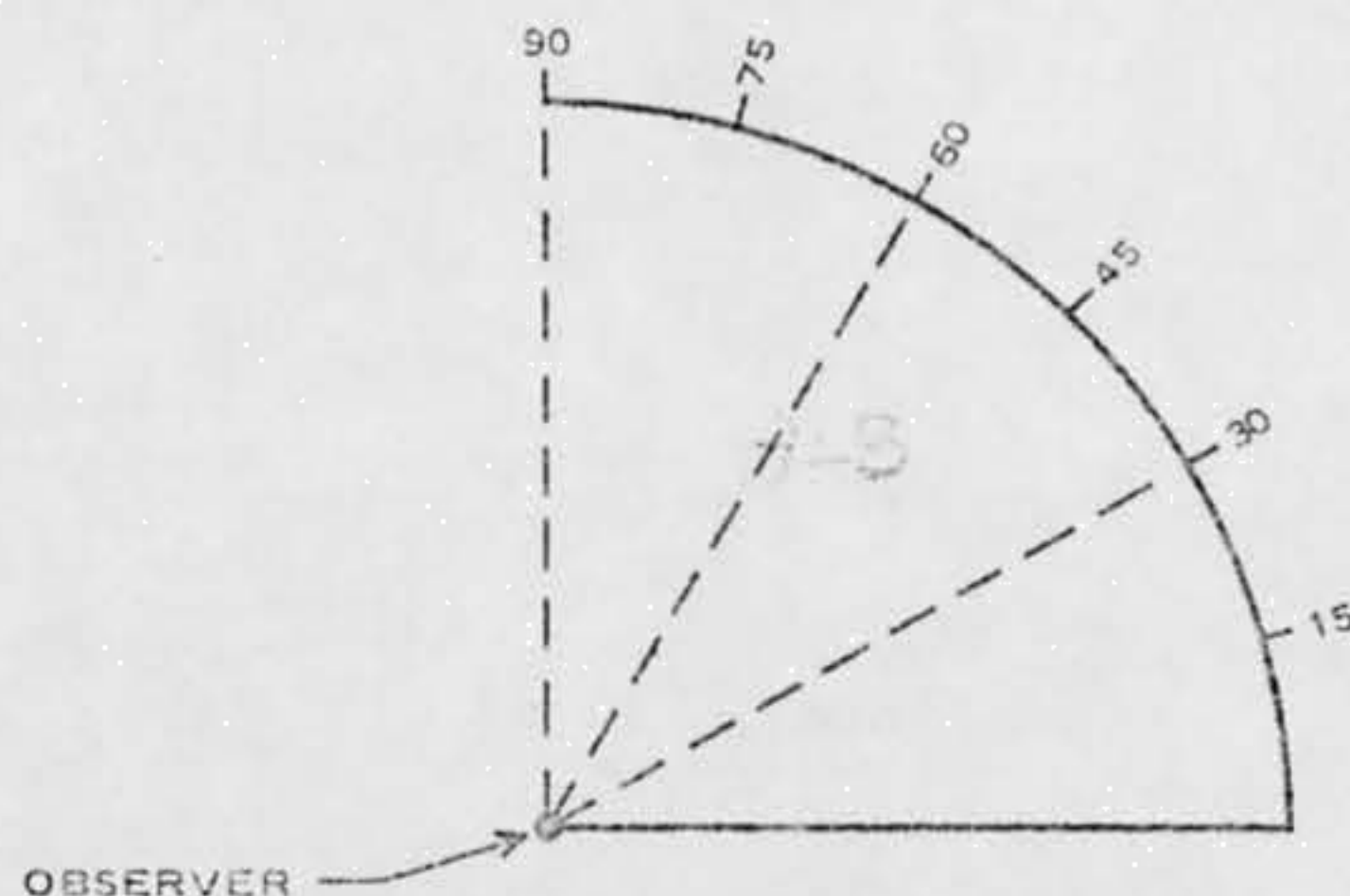

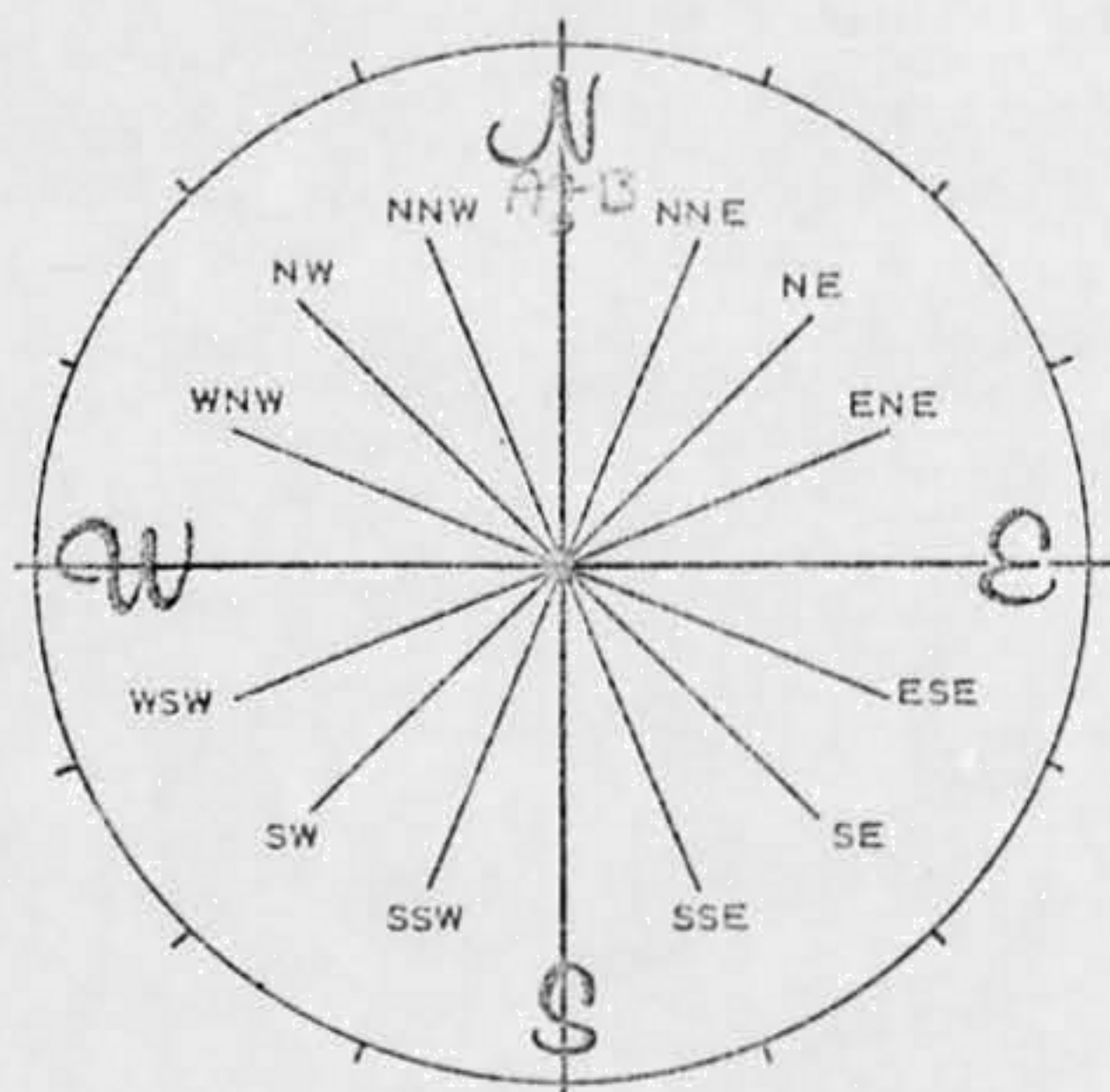

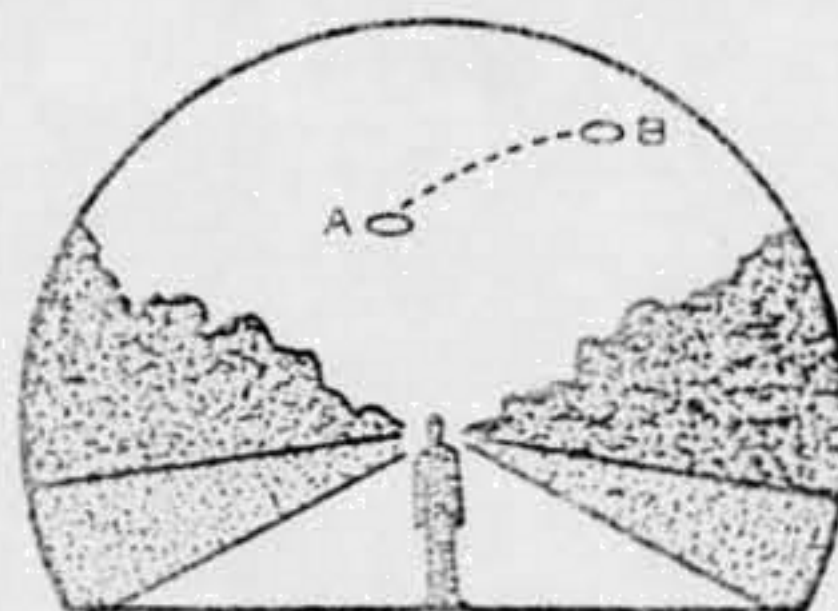
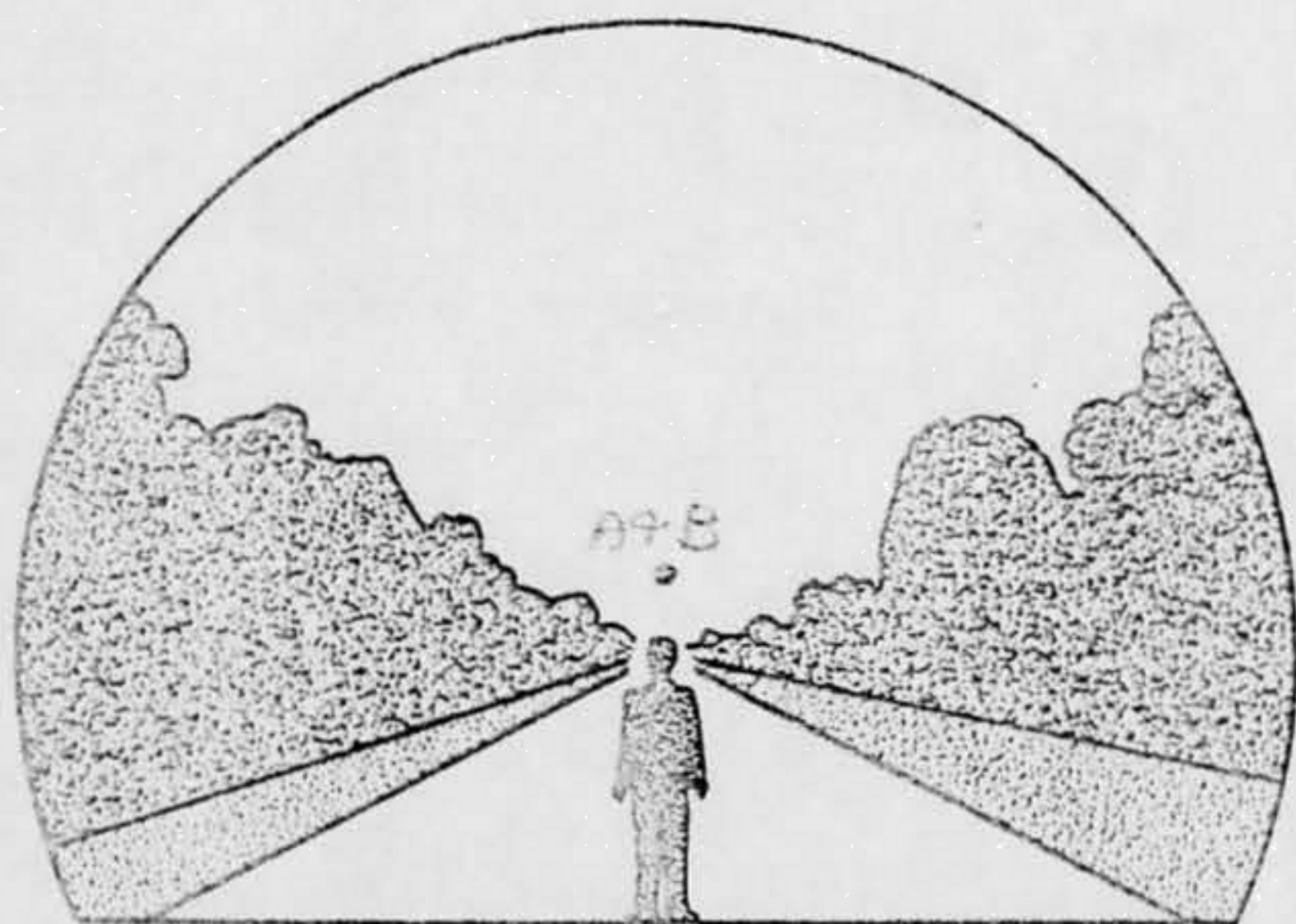

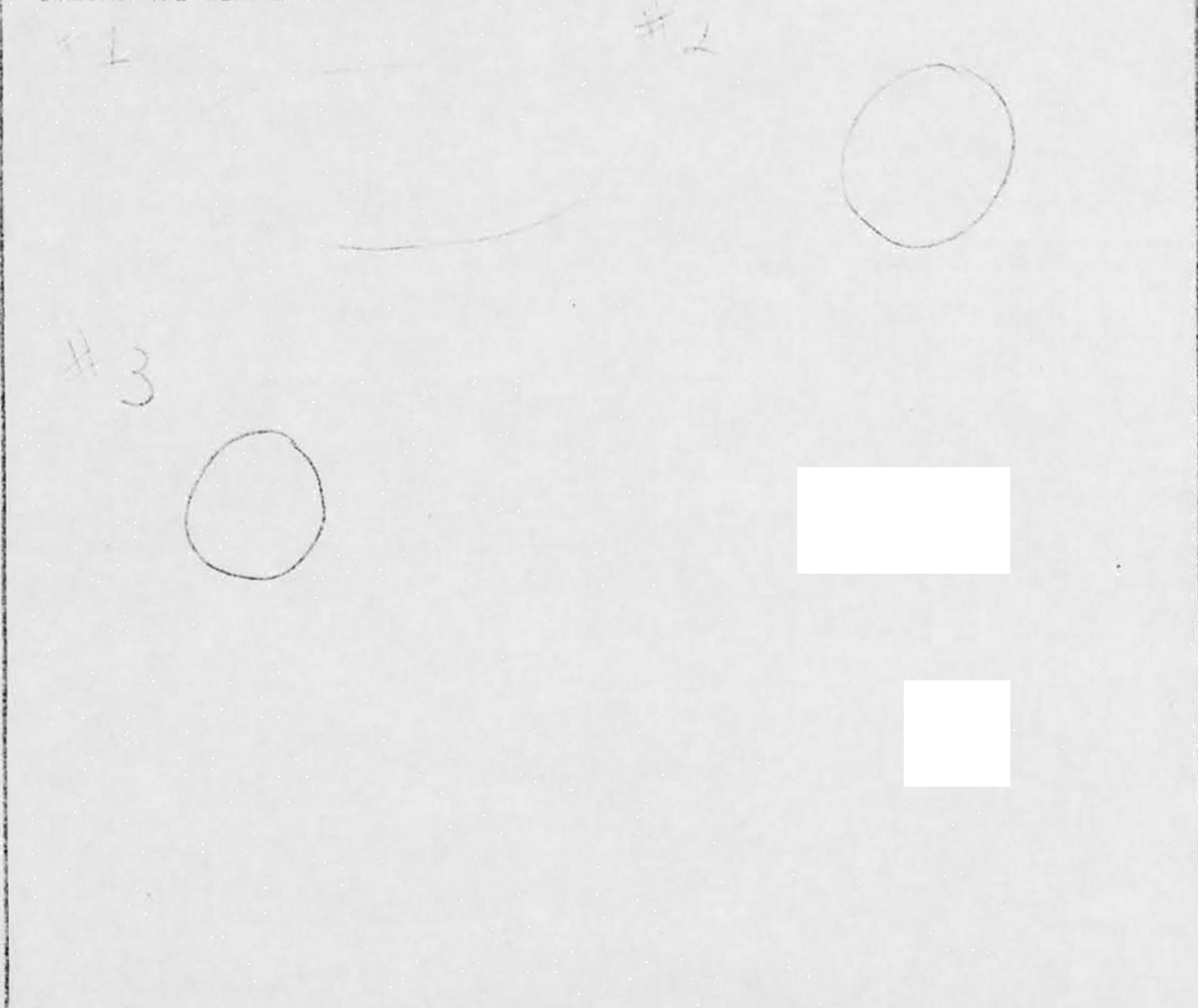
