I would like to report a Unidentified Flying Object sighted on the night of August 21, 1968. Here is a brief outline of what the night was like:

I. Conditions on Night of Sighting

- a. Clear Sky
- b. No moon
- c. Slightly chilly
- d. Humid air
- e. Number of objects seen - three (3)
- f. Number of Witnesses - five (Approx.)

It went on a constant path with no irregular or jerky movements. It was sighted above Camp Kvutza Galil. It is a Habonim camp in Ottsville, Bucks County, Pa.

I have enclosed a picture of one of the objects. It was taken by a Polaroid Swinger Camera, Film Type 20.

I had the film checked and there was no defect in the film.

I have also enclosed the negative. Please return both and reply to this letter.

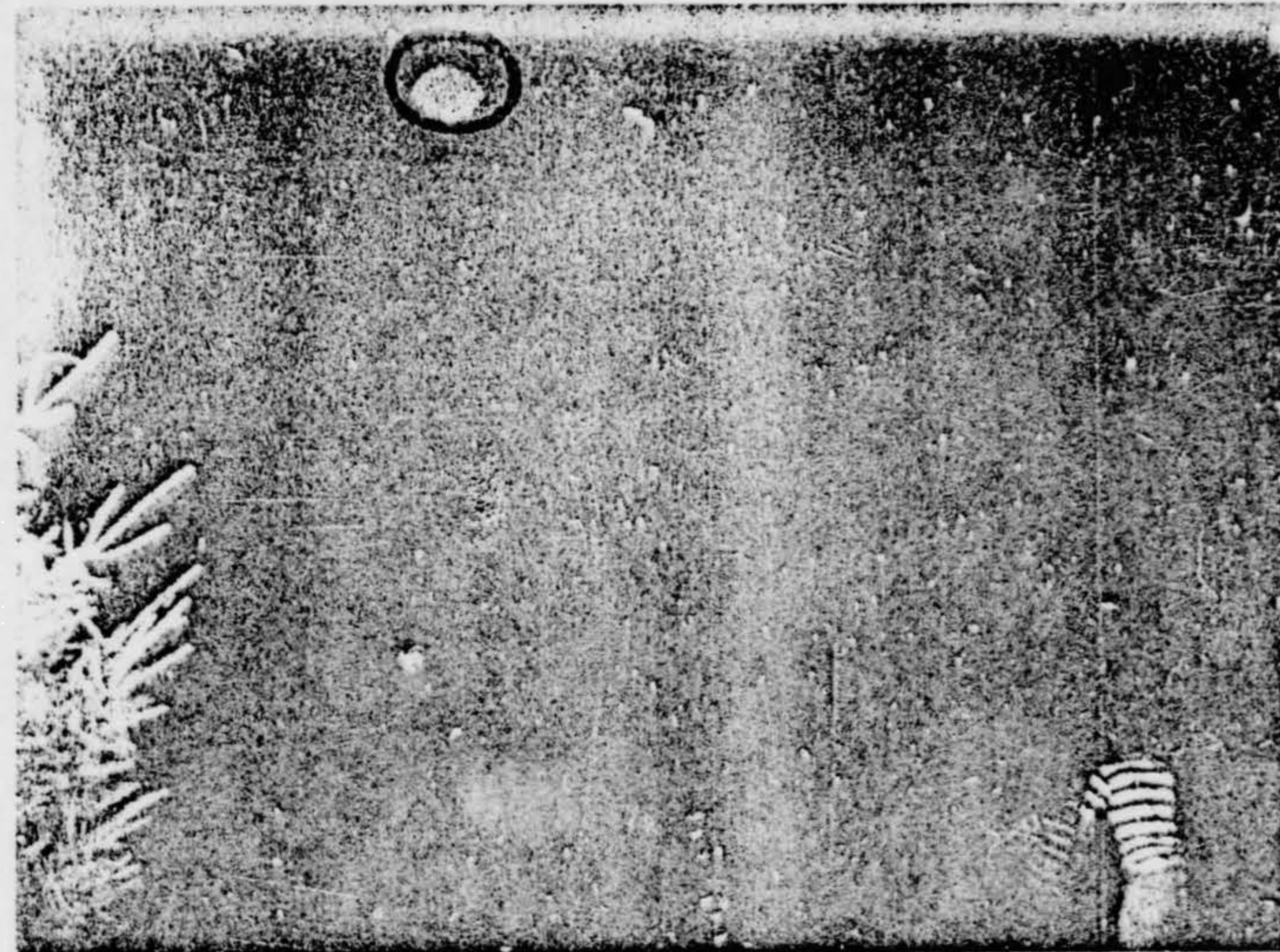

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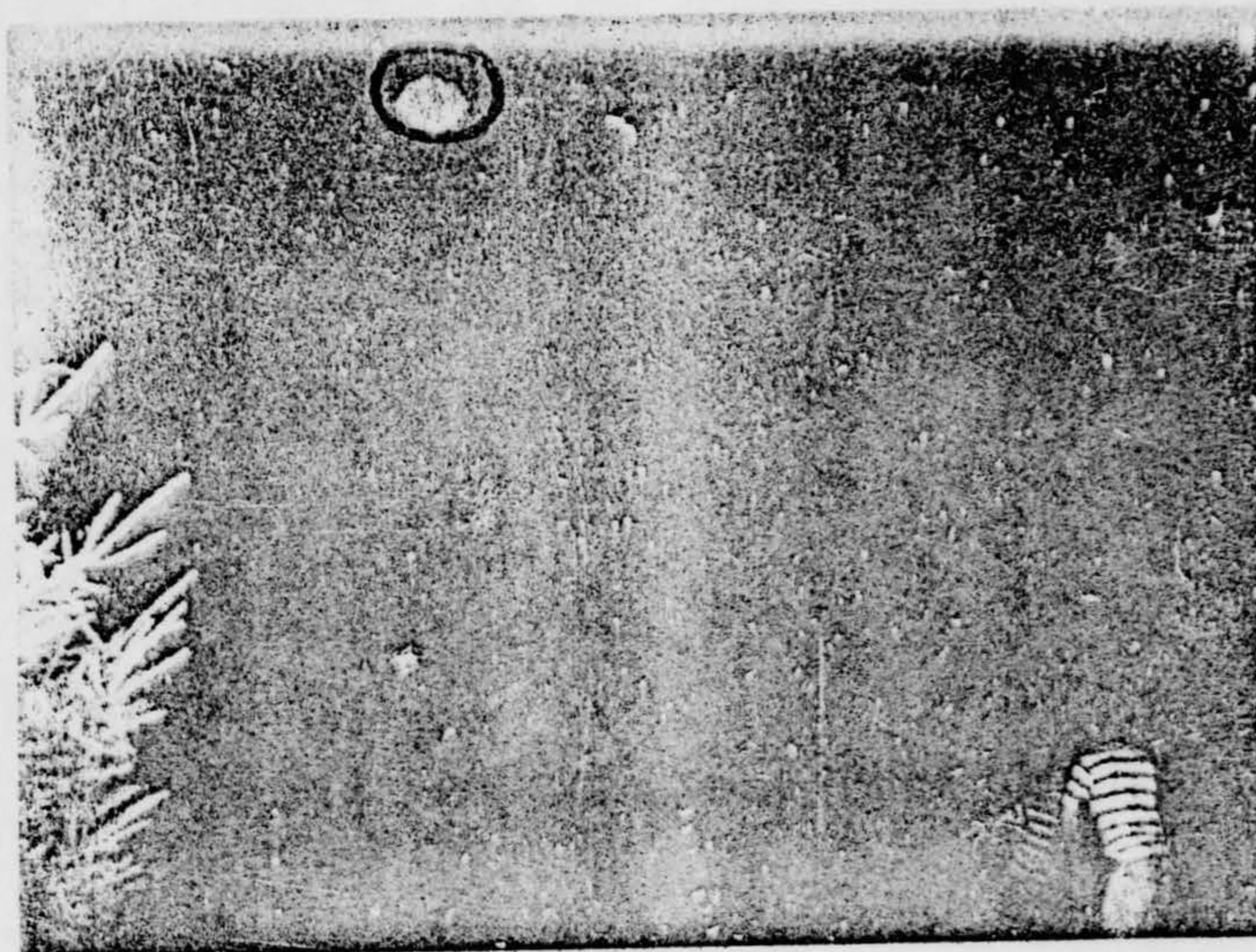
