6. TYPE OF OBSERVATION GROUND-VISUAL	COMMENTS: The observers at one point described the light as simply a light, yet in another as a large fireworks sparkler. No mention is made if there were any sparks or not. Also the distance of the light is given as "100 feet but it could have been miles away." Camarillo is quite close to several airfields. The sighting may have been of a plane, a meteor, a hot air balloon, a weather balloon, etc. However, since the sighting is of a light it does not really meet the definition of a UFO as given in AFR 80-17. All that can be said is that there is not enough information to determine what the light was attached to.

The witnesses drove into their driveway about midnight 28 Aug. 68. As they were getting out of car, the wife noticed a well defined light hovering above the roof of their house, in a shape described previously. She pointed it out to her husband and they watched it move slowly across the roof (although they both stated it could have been miles away). If it was just above the roof, then it would have appeared to be about 16-20" across. It moved in a jerky motion, and then seemed to dart away very quickly, ("faster than a jet") and was lost sight of behind a grove of avocado trees. The witnesses appeared creditable, but not experienced in observing visual phenomena.

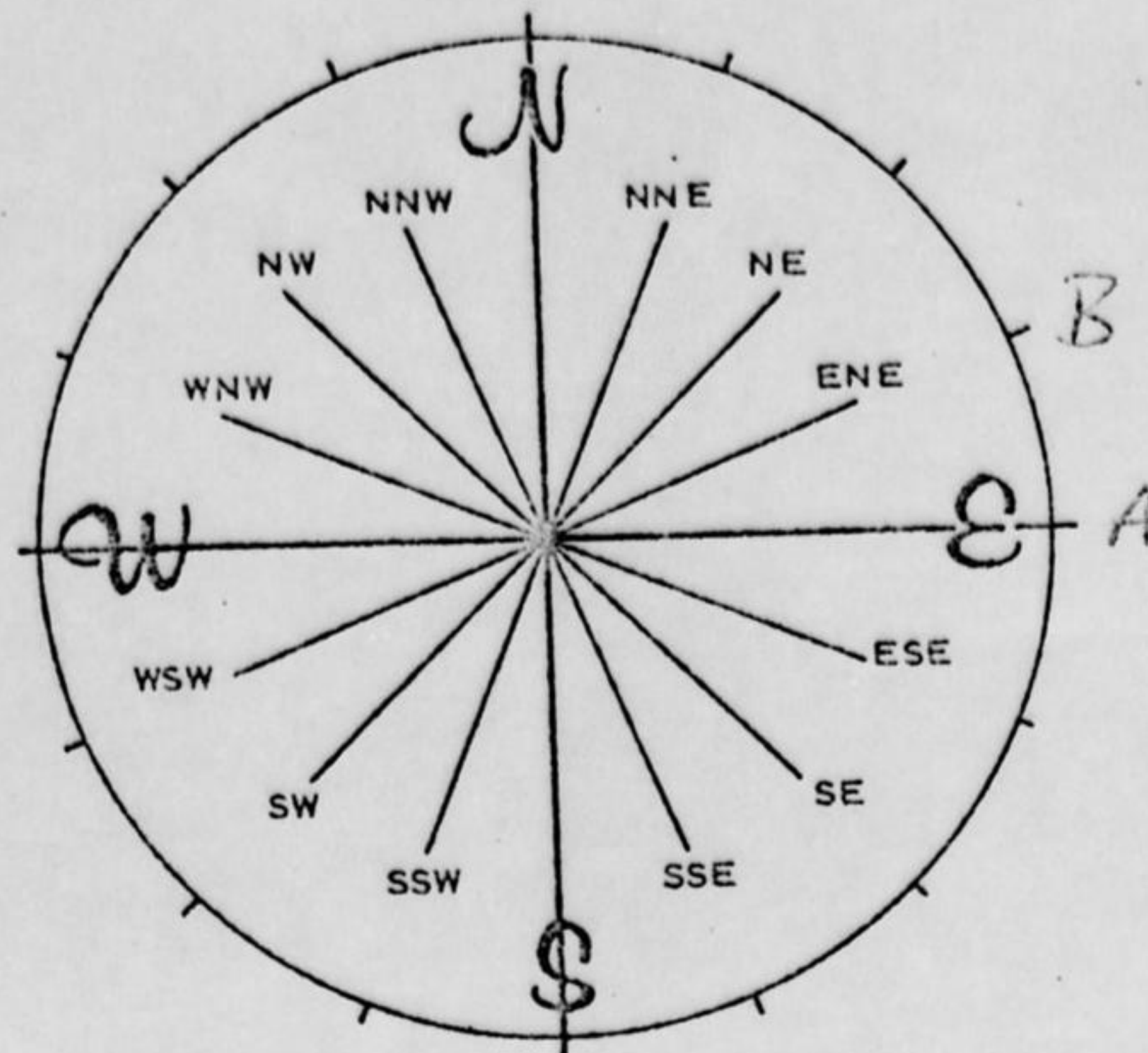

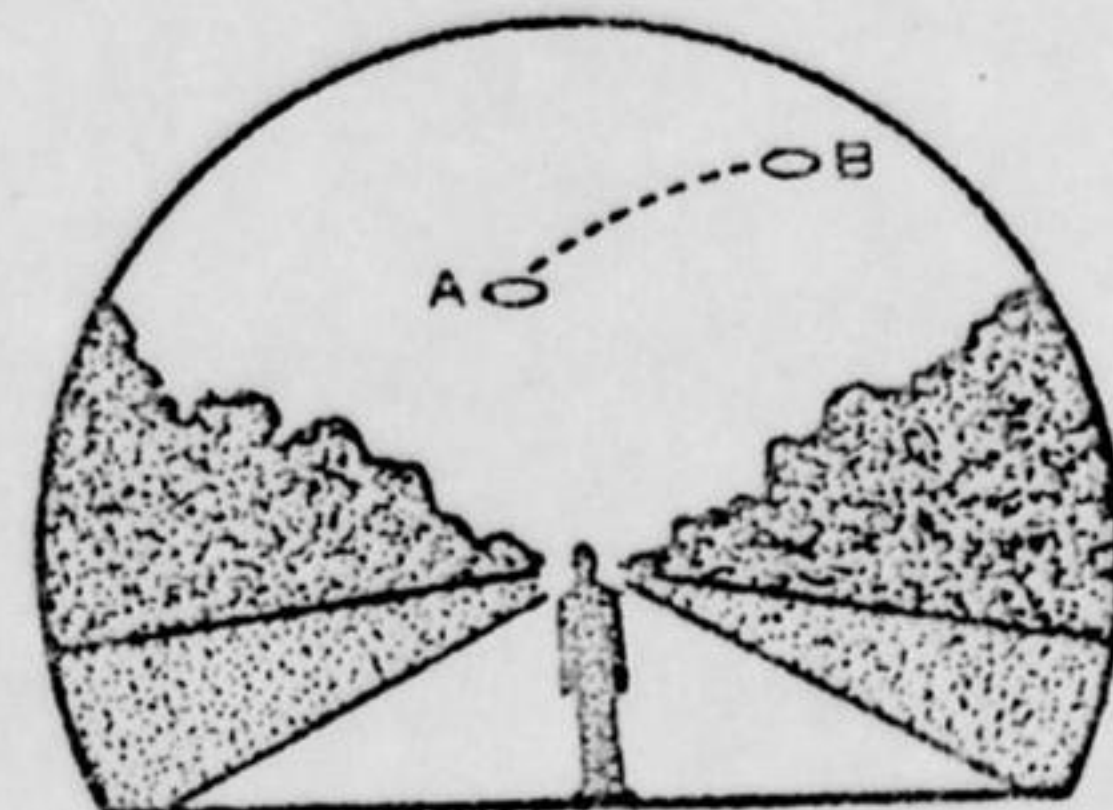
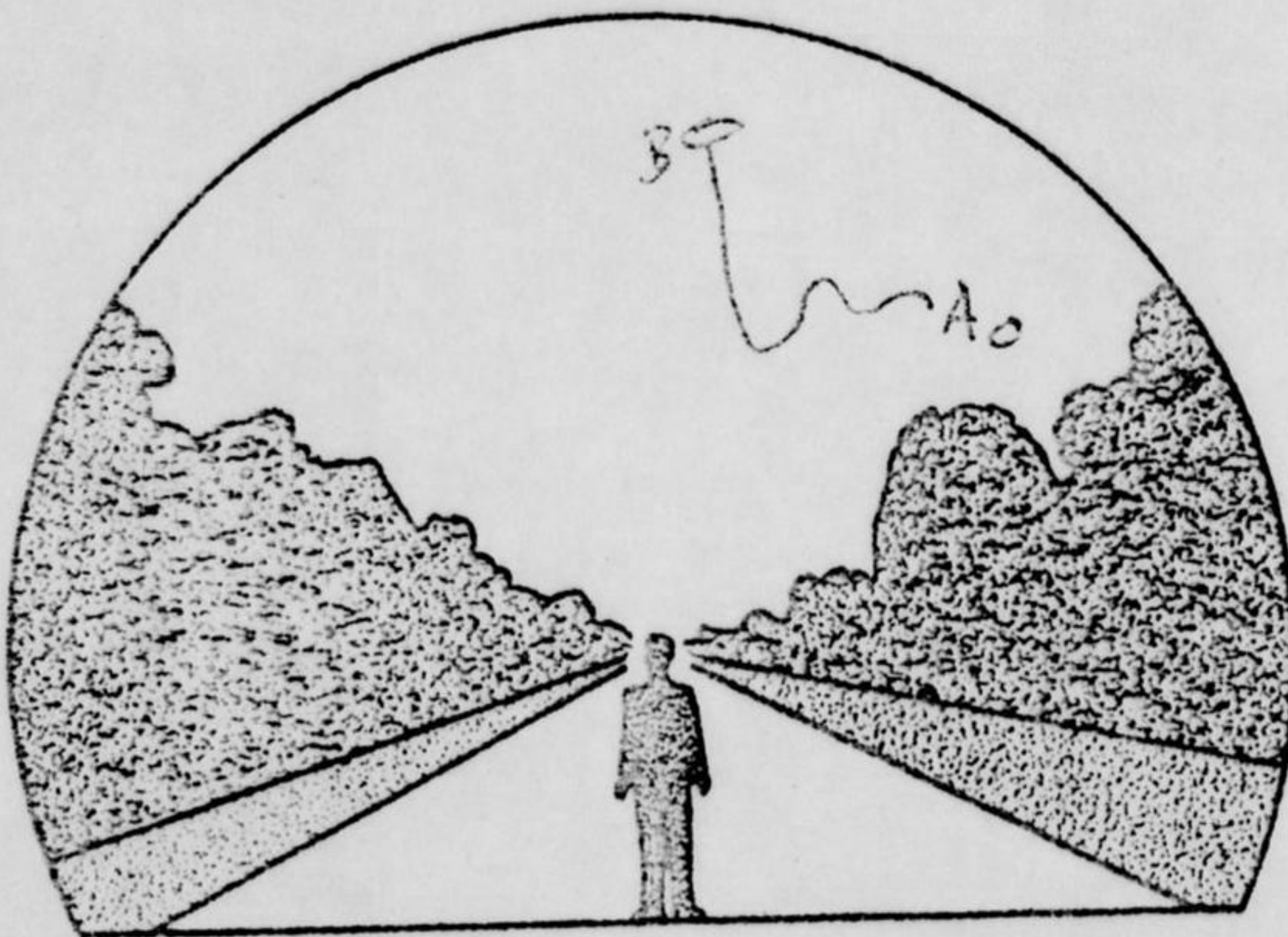

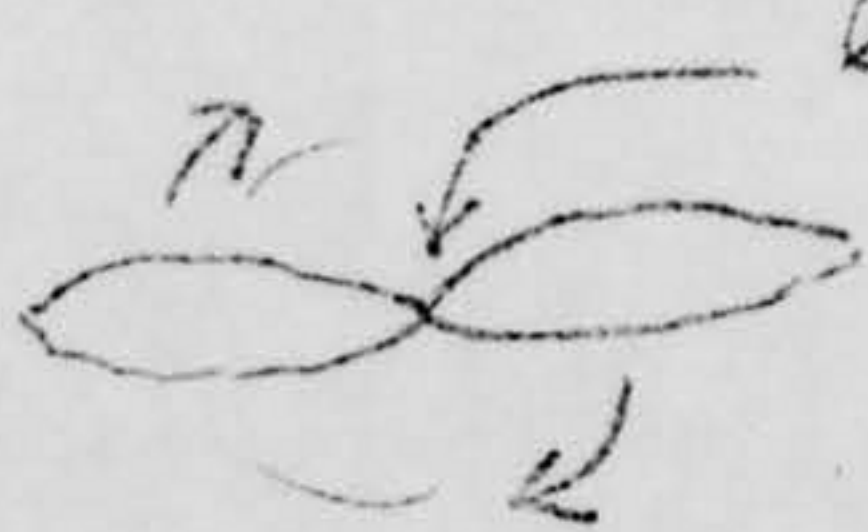
