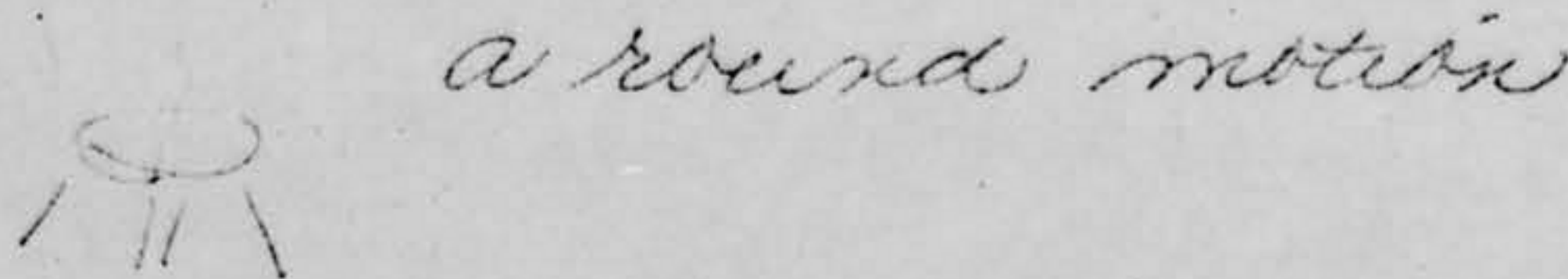

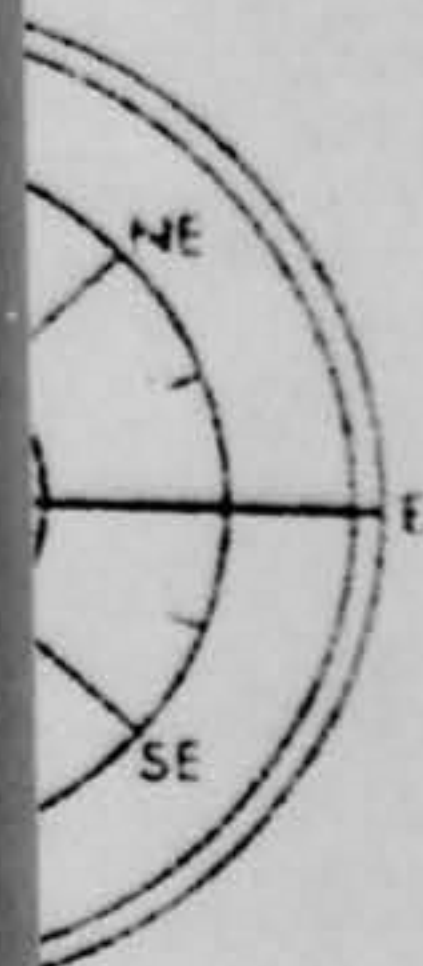
There were people in Fairview watching the objects with us but we did not get to talk to them.
