Dear Sir,

I wrote to Dr. Condon at the
University of Colorado November ninth
about U. F. O. sightings but the
project office is closed.

He sent me your address.

This is not a report of an
individual sighting such as anyone
may have. They appear in such
numbers and so frequently anyone
can see them.

Apparently they congregate here

in Southern Element because²
the mountains keep our radar
from finding them. They also keep
low. They fly up and down and
sideways. They make no sound.

One large U. S. O. had a white
light in the center, blue lights on
top and red lights on the bottom.

Another I watched, flew from
the north, along the western horizon,
then toward the south. It was
saucer shaped with a circle of lights
which revolved in a circle as it
slowly flew with no sound.

Wednesday the 27th driving up Coast
Street toward the First National
Shopping Center there was a large
white U. S. O. It merely hung in

Great shafts of white light
shot into the sky lighting up that
area.

My sister [redacted] and her
daughter have made several
sightings of flying saucers
during the last twelve years.

But during the last six months
the U. S. A.s have become much
more numerous and are now of
a more sophisticated design.

We feel that we are under

Guilford, I suspect it's their home
base.

One evening when I drove out to
Guilford there were four red U. S. O's.
Three dis appeared. The fourth flew
a short way further south and
apparently landed.
